**NOTICE TO ALL EMPLOYEES**

The following applies if you are involved in a work-related injury:

1. If you suffer a work-related injury, your employer or its insurance company is required to pay for reasonable surgical and medical services and supplies, orthopedic appliances and prostheses, including training in their use.
2. In order to insure that your medical treatment will be paid for by your employer or the insurance company, you must select one of the licensed physicians or practitioners of the healing arts listed below:

3. You must continue to visit one of the practitioners listed above if you require treatment during the first 90 days from the date of your initial visit.
4. After this 90-day period, if you still need treatment, you may choose to go to another licensed physician or practitioner of the healing arts for treatment. You should notify your employer within 5 days of your visit to the person of your choice. Your bills will be paid if your licensed physician or practitioner of the healing arts files reports as required (these reports must be filed within 30 days after your first visit and at least once a month for as long as treatment continues).
5. If one of the persons listed above refers you to another licensed specialist, your employer or his insurance company will pay the bill for these services.
